

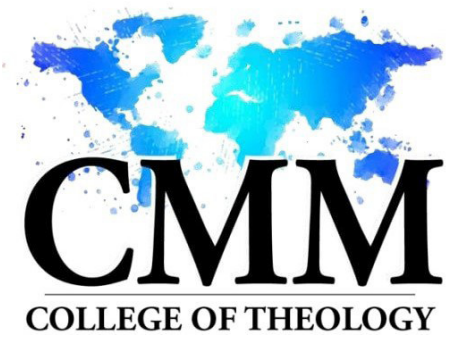

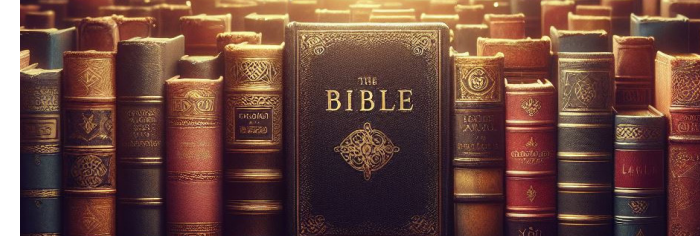
**Courses for Christian Counseling Certification only*
