Both programs (CMM & NCCA) are accredited through AICCS.

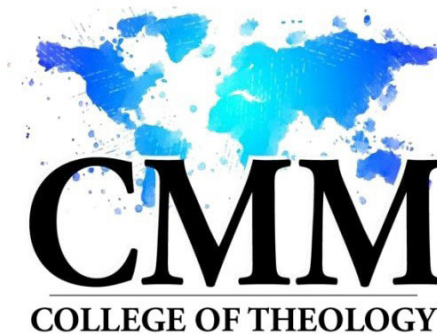
